
Base Pay: \$55,000 - \$75,000 per year

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coordinates and supervises the daily activities of warehouse personnel
- Sets priorities for the team to ensure task completion; coordinates work activities with other supervisors
- Applies expertise to solve standard and non-standard problems within own area
- Works/brainstorms with management team and supports the focus on operational excellence
- Oversee the inspection, processing and shelving of all inbound productions
- Schedule and lead all monthly cycle counts. Reconcile actual counts versus system perpetual
- Coordinate with Accounting and External Auditors and lead year end facility counts
- Organize all materials and ensure that system records remain up-to-date
- Buy material and services as needed to ensure smooth operation of production lines
- Partner with project management and production to project resource requirements and maintains adequate inventory levels
- Coordinate with Procurement to ensure a best-in-class contingent of suppliers and vendors
- Analyze requisition to ensure legitimacy, necessity and conformance to regulations
- Identify and implement cost reduction initiatives (in conjunction with Procurement) for facility's services and consumable items
- Solicit bids from acceptable/qualified potential sources of non contracted materials/services and prepare Request for Quotations (RFQ) documentation, conduct bidders conferences, & resolve questions prior to bid closing date. Evaluate quotations, perform cost & price analysis, collect market based pricing information, and analyze alternative methods
